Principal Mark Toulouse will retire on 30 June 2016 and in accordance with the by-laws of the Board of Regents of Victoria University, the President has appointed a committee to review the College prior to entering into a search for a new Principal. The primary object of the review is to make key recommendations for the College's future directions and activities in the next five years.

Members of the Committee are: William Robins, President; Ms. Wanda Chin, Emmanuel College Registrar; Professor Pamela Couture; Professor Tom Reynolds; and Professor Nevin Reda.

The President has also asked two external reviewers to assist with the task. Professor Jack Fitzmier, Executive Director, American Academy of Religion, and Professor Sandra Beardsall, Professor of Church History and Ecumenics, St. Andrews College, Saskatoon, will visit the campus in late November, meeting with members of the Vic community. They will be consulting widely with faculty, student and administrative members of Emmanuel College and with members of the Victoria University, Toronto School of Theology, and University of Toronto communities. The report of the external reviewers will be provided to the members of the Review Committee. The Review Committee will then draft a Report in early 2017.
