**Call to Order and Opening Prayer:**

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Professor M Bourgeois.

**Memorial Resolution:**

The following resolution in memory of the late Professor Emeritus **Kingsley John Joblin** was presented by Professor A J Johnston:

**Kingsley John Joblin (1912-2003)**

Kingsley Joblin was born in Toronto February 23, 1912. He graduated from Victoria College at the age of 20 in 1932 winning the Prince of Wales Gold Medal in arts. Four years later he graduated from Emmanuel College, again with a gold medal, and was ordained in the United Church of Canada. For the next decade he served as a minister in the United Church first as an assistant in Deer Park Church (where he was a member at the time of his death July 15, 2003) and then in Westminster Church, Toronto. During the Second World War he served as chaplain to the Canadian Naval Reserve.

In 1946 he began his long career as a member of the Department of Religious Studies at Victoria College that ended with his retirement in 1977. During this time he served as chair of his department (1952-70), as college chaplain (1956-70) and as acting principal (1964-5). In 1962-63 he was visiting professor at Chung Chi College, University of Hong Kong. After his retirement in 1977 he continued to be a welcome presence on the Vic campus and in the Senior Common Room joining his old friends for lunch every Tuesday as long as he was able.

He was a beloved and effective teacher whose wide knowledge of the sacred texts of many religions brought deep insights to his many devoted students. He was also famous as a story teller whose lectures were peppered with the phrase 'And that reminds me...' that would precede an anecdote that, far from being irrelevant, would reinforce the academic point that he had just been making. His wide range of interests and his great intellectual curiosity made him an invaluable member of his department. He had a deep and well-informed knowledge of hymnody and other sacred music and was one of the driving forces behind the purchase and installation of the organ in the Victoria Chapel in the 1960s – one of the first 'tracker' organs in Toronto. He was also a 'father in God' to countless students who sought his counsel with personal and spiritual problems. Among his articles, text books and monographs perhaps the most remarkable were the two that he published at the age of 90 on the study of scripture and a biography of his brother Elgie.

In the citation to this Senate recommending that he be made a professor emeritus in 1977, his life long friend Northrop Frye wrote,

... he personified, as very few others have done, the true ethos of Victoria, that blend of Methodist piety and love of learning that inspired its founders: an ethos that interprets faith and reason as complementary rather than contradictory terms ...

Victoria has lost one of its finest sons. Those of us who knew, loved and were inspired by him mourn his loss.

I move that this appreciation of the life and work of Kingsley John Joblin be enscribed in the minutes of the Senate and that a copy be sent to his family.

**The resolution was given assent with a standing vote and a minute of silence.**

Professor Johnston reminded everyone of the memorial service for Kingsley Joblin to be held on Thursday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Registrar McDonald reported that the final enrolment figure for 2003-04 would be established on November 1, 2003, but that it would likely be close to 3,950 - shy of the 4,000 mark that was anticipated for this year.

**Report of the Acting Registrar, Emmanuel College:**

Enrolment:

Figures remain fluid at this point in the semester, but some overall trends can be highlighted.

Advanced Degree enrolment has risen more than 25% since 2001; 73% of the AD students receive scholarship or financial assistance, thanks to the generosity of Victoria University.

Admissions to the Basic Degree stream number 44 this term as opposed to 33 one year ago. It is a hopeful sign that the number of Full Time Basic Degree students has risen markedly, though a larger number remain in the Part Time category.

Diversity

We have been blessed in welcoming our first exchange students under the program called INATE (International Network for Advanced Theological Education). They are Thor-Arne Johansen from Norway, and André Musskopf from Brazil.

**Report of the Awards Committee:**

The Senate Awards Committee met on **Tuesday, Sept 30th**. At this meeting, the Committee dealt with a number of items. First we received a report from the Secretary on the admission and in-course awards that were issued to Victoria College students over the summer months. The secretary noted that 407 Victoria College students received in-course awards: 135 in first year, 132 in second year and 140 in third year.

On behalf of the Senate Awards Committee, the Secretary moved:

**THAT** an award to be known as **the Pauline Mills McGibbon Scholarship** be established in Victoria College to be awarded annually to a student with an overall A average who is registered in the Frye Stream of the Vic One Program.

and

**THAT** an award to be known as **the Mary Mounfield Scholarship** be established in Victoria College to be awarded annually to a student with overall A standing who is registered in the VicOne program.

and

**THAT** an award to be known as **the Lilly and Nathan Strauss Q.C. Scholarship** be established in Victoria College to be awarded annually to the student who obtains the highest standing in the Pearson Stream of the Vic One program.

The motion was seconded by Professor McLeod and **CARRIED**.

The third item that the Awards Committee turned its attention to was a review of scholarship spending at Victoria College for the past 10 years. Statistics were presented that demonstrated how much this program has grown during the past 10 years.

In 1993, a total of 160 Victoria College students received admission and in-course awards. By 2003, this had grown to 545. The amount of resources allocated had increased from \$407,000 in 1993 to over \$900,000 in 2003. The Secretary explained that the current policy of guaranteeing a scholarship of \$1000 to all Victoria College students achieving an overall A after completing their 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years was straining the awards budget.

The Secretary explained that even with the \$60,000 in OTO funds (transferred from Senate Research funds), which was approved by Senate at the meeting June 2003, the College ran short of funds by approximately \$25,000. The Committee spent much time discussing the merits of the current policy of guaranteeing students awards. The Committee members agreed that the guarantee was a great incentive for all Victoria College students and was an effective recruitment draw and that every effort should be made to continue the guarantee. The Awards Committee also agreed that Victoria University will need to look for ways to ensure that the College had the resources needed to continue this important program.

**President's Report:**

President Gooch proposed the establishment of a visiting position at Victoria named in recognition of the work and contributions of Chancellor Taylor, who is completing his final year, and his wife Dr Patricia Taylor. The name of the position is The Kenneth and Patricia Taylor Distinguished Visitor in Foreign Affairs; this name will be used when the visitor spends a short period of time in the Vic One program. When (as is the case this year) the visitor is teaching an entire course, the title will be The Kenneth and Patricia Taylor Distinguished Visiting Professor in Foreign Affairs. The first holder of this Distinguished Visiting Professorship is David Wright, the Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Canada to NATO from 1997-2003.

Ms H Apesteguy-Reux moved, seconded by Dr Kushner, that Senate approve the establishment of the Kenneth and Patricia Taylor Distinguished Visitor in Foreign Affairs position.

Dr Jay commented that he was very pleased as the Vic One program and this new position are appropriate symbols of the commitments of the heritage of Victoria University.

The motion **CARRIED**.

President Gooch pointed out that at the June meeting of Senate the Nominating Committee had not staffed the Senate Teaching Award Committee. The Victoria University Teaching Award has not been given out since 2000 and last year, when a call went out for nominations, no new nominations were submitted. Given all this, the President thought it would be appropriate to explore other ways to honour the teaching and research accomplishments of the Victoria University faculty. He proposes that Senate strike a working group to recognize faculty accomplishments and invited members of Senate (students, alumni, etc) to volunteer to serve on this working group. He also encouraged everyone to send any suggestions or comments directly to him or to the Secretary of Senate.

Mr Kopolovic commented that one of the problems with the current teaching award is that many Victoria College students are not taught by Victoria professors.

Mrs Breukelman asked if this working group would be duplicating the numerous teaching awards at the University of Toronto. In response, President Gooch reiterated that for the last several years the Victoria University Teaching Award has not been awarded and suggested that we should create a different type of honour to recognize excellence amongst the teaching staff and not just restrict ourselves to teaching awards. Dr Kushner agreed and noted that the Teaching Award in the Faculty for Arts and Science takes the place of the Victoria University Teaching Award.

President Gooch noted that while the Victoria University full-time Chaplain position was eliminated last year, some of the work done by this position had been picked up by the Reverend Susan Garrod-Schuster, the ecumenical Chaplain at Knox College. He stated that Ms Garrod-Schuster will be available on Tuesdays for Emmanuel College students and on every other Wednesday for Victoria College students. The President suggested that it would be useful to have a working group to act as a reference for Susan Garrod-Schuster, especially for Victoria College, and once again called for volunteers to serve on this working group. He suggested that it would be particularly useful to have student members on this group and encouraged them to consider this opportunity.

President Gooch also presented the following list of upcoming projects/activities for the University for this year:

- 1) Searches for a new Chancellor and Bursar.
- 2) Contractual/Legal – Arts & Science memorandum of agreement to be reviewed.
- 3) Memorandum with TST up for re-negotiation.
- 4) Academic Initiatives – Vic Council and EM Council, future academic programs, relations with faculty of Music, OISE/UT.
- 5) Review of Renaissance Studies Program and CRRS – developing a clearer relationship between the Centre and the Program.
