VICTORIA UNIVERSITY COVID-19 SAFETY LIST (MARCH 15, 2022)

Victoria University has suspended the use of the General Assessment Tool (GAT) and the EAT (Event Assessment Tool) in keeping with the loosening of restrictions within the Province. In their place, organizers of on-campus activities can use this list in their planning. This list and any related policies and procedures will be reviewed and updated on an ongoing basis.

1)	Physical distancing in masked indoor areas is no longer required. Two-metre distancing is still required in eating areas or at events that include food.
2)	Masks are required to be worn in all indoor University spaces and medical masks are recommended. See more information at https://vicu.utoronto.ca/covid-19-updates .
3)	A self-screening assessment through <u>UCheck</u> is required every day before coming to campus. Visitors are required to complete a <u>paper-based screening form.</u>
4)	All individuals must be fully vaccinated before coming onto Victoria University's premises. See more information at https://vicu.utoronto.ca/covid-19-updates . Visitors are required to complete a paper-based screening form, which includes a vaccine attestation.
6)	 COVID-19 signage: COVID-19 posters, including those listed below, may be requested from Victoria University's Department of Infrastructure and Sustainability (vic.is@utoronto.ca). COVID-19 Vaccination, Symptoms Self-Screening Poster COVID-19 UCheck Poster COVID-19 Entry Mask Poster
7)	Procedures for COVID-19 illness (symptomatic or confirmed). If individuals answer "YES" to any <u>UCheck</u> screening questions, be advised that they should not come to campus and should self-isolate at home immediately. They should also contact their health care provider or Telehealth Ontario (1 866-797-0000) to find out if they need a COVID-19 test. Victoria University employees should update their manager regarding their absence and notify Human Resources by emailing <u>vic.hr@utoronto.ca</u> .
8)	 Infection control measures: Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes stations at strategic locations (e.g., entrances, washrooms, kitchenettes, shared equipment areas) Provision of dedicated equipment/tools Disinfection of shared objects and surfaces
